
Exempt Property - Fla. Stat. § 732.402



If not, no exempt property under F.S. 732.402.



Is there a surviving spouse?

If not, did D have children?

If no surviving spouse and no children, no exempt property under F.S. 732.402.



What property may be exempt?



Benefits under "section 529" prepaid college tuition



Up to two motor vehicles ≤ 15,000 lbs

in D's name and regularly used by D or D's immediate family as regular vehicle



If household furniture, furnishings, and appliances in D's usual place of abode, then up to net value of \$20,000 exempt.



Plans and death benefits for teachers or school administrators per F.S. 112.1915



No later than 4 months after date of service of NOA or date that is 40 days after end of proceeding re: construction, admission, or validity of Will...

BUT WAIT

- 1. Was property that would otherwise be exempt specifically or demonstratively devised? If yes, not exempt property unless devised to someone who would otherwise be entitled to it as exempt property under Fla. Stat. § 732.402
- 2. Was right to exempt property waived?
- 3. Was Petition to Determine Exempt Property timely filed?
